# Welcome Back!

#### Attention: Past Potato Festival Parade Participants and Newcomers

In 2024, the Alliston Potato Festival will be held from the 9<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup> of August. This year's **Parade**, brought to you by the Rotary Club of Alliston, will be held on **Friday, 9 August 2024** as part of the Festival's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration. If you were with us for the parade in 2023, we hope you'll be back. If you were unable to attend last year, we look forward to your participation in 2024.

The maximum number of entries for the parade is 65. The deadline for applications to be received is Friday, 2 August 2024, or earlier if the maximum number of entries is reached. For insurance and security reasons, <u>late applications will not be accepted.</u>

**Parade participants will begin to assemble no later than 5:45 p.m. on Friday, 9 August.** The parade will start at 7:00 p.m. at Banting Memorial High School (203 Victoria Street East in Alliston), proceed west on Victoria Street to Ontario Street, and then south on Ontario Street to Nelson Street. Smaller exhibits or walking participants may turn east and disassemble in the parking lot of the Alliston Arena, as in past years. Large trucks, machinery or floats that cannot make the turn onto Nelson Street from Ontario will be directed southward to Albert Street to exit the parade area. The OPP and marshals from the Alliston Rotary Club will be on Ontario Street to assist with traffic flow. You can return to the parade starting area at the high school by using Albert Street, which will remain open throughout the parade.

## **IMPORTANT**

FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, CANDY, SOUVENIRS OR OTHER OBJECTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE THROWN TO THE SPECTATORS BY PARTICIPANTS ON YOUR FLOAT OR IN YOUR PROCESSION. Any group failing to abide by this requirement will not be permitted to participate in future parades. Please also exercise caution when moving along the parade route -- young children tend to wander into the street.

# **Best of the Parade Awards**

For the convenience of the judges and spectators, and for greater awareness of your organization, we ask that you **display your name in a prominent place** on your float or in your procession. To assist the TV commentators, please ensure your organization name is also on the *front* of your float or vehicle.

Prior to the start of the parade, the Rotary judging team will cruise the lineup of participants and select a winner in each of two categories:

(1) Best Float - NOT-FOR-PROFIT; and

(2) Best Float – COMMERCIAL.

The judging criteria include the presence of potatoes, evidence of effort, number of participants, and overall attractiveness.

*Judging* will take place in the parade formation area, starting *at 6:00 p.m.* If your float is not in position at that time, it will not be judged. The decision of the judges will be final.

## Maintaining the Correct Parade Order

Parade order is determined by the Parade Committee and, for reasons of security and broadcast accuracy, must not be altered. There will be parade marshals in attendance east of the high school lot to assist you with getting into the correct parade position. The marshals together with the OPP have the authority to expel any entrant not following the guidelines set out on pages 1-2 of this document.

#### **Payment and Position**

The Parade Committee will contact you by email to confirm receipt of application and payment. You will be contacted again by e-mail not later than Monday, 5 August with your position/entry number.
